FACT FINDER

Series: Deadliest Animals

Objective

To help students look for key details as they read a book about a wild animal.

Supplies

- · One or more books in the Deadliest Animals series
- Fact Finder worksheet (attached)
- Pencils

Before the Activity

Print a copy of the Fact Finder worksheet for each student.

Activity

Each book in the Deadliest Animals series describes how an animal survives in the wild. Each animal has its own ways to avoid predators or catch prey. To help readers identify these key details, pass out the Fact Finder worksheets. Then, have each student read a book from the Deadliest Animals series. As students read, they should look for the answers to the questions on the worksheet. Students should write each answer as a complete sentence.

Evaluation

Collect the worksheets and give each student 1 point for each correct answer, for up to 4 points total.
