

# **LESSON PLAN**

### REMARKABLE REPTILES

Series: Reptiles

## **Objective**

To help students find and describe key ideas while reading a nonfiction book about reptiles.

#### **Supplies**

- · One or more books in the Reptiles series
- Remarkable Reptiles worksheet (attached)
- Pencils

#### **Before the Activity**

Print a copy of the Remarkable Reptiles worksheet for each student.

#### **Activity**

Each book in the Reptiles series focuses on a different reptile, describing what it eats, where it lives, and if it has any special abilities, such as blending in with its surroundings or using a strong sense of smell to find prey.

Invite each student to choose one book from the Reptiles series to read for this activity. Then pass out the Remarkable Reptiles worksheet. Explain that it includes eight questions about the book's main ideas. Students should look for the answers to these questions as they read. They should write their answers on the worksheet. Remind students to write each answer as a complete sentence.

#### **Evaluation**

Collect the worksheets at the end of the activity. Could students find an answer to each of the eight questions? Did they write each answer as a complete sentence?
